COURSE PROVISIONS

Frankenmuth Driving School will provide a minimum of 6 hours of classroom instruction by a certified instructor. Classroom instruction will not exceed 2 hours per day.

TERMS

1. The student, parent, or guardian agrees to remit \$50 payable by cash, check or money order to Frankenmuth Driving School no later than the first day of class.
2. The student must provide a Level 1 License and driving log signed by a parent or guardian to verify eligibility for the course (see "Required Language" below).
3. The student must satisfactorily complete all classroom assignments. A minimum score of 70% must be achieved on the final test. Up to two retakes are allowed.
4. The student must attend all three class periods. No make-ups are offered.

REQUIRED LANGUAGE

NOTICE – this driver education provider is required to be certified by the Secretary of State. If you have any complaint that cannot be settled with the provider, please complete the Driver Education Complaint form found under "Driver Programs Division" on the Department of State website: www.michigan.gov/sos. Completing driver education does not guarantee a driver's license.

A minimum of 30 hours of supervised driving, including two hours of nighttime driving, on a Level 1 license that has been held for at least three continuous months must be completed before a student can be accepted into Segment Two. Supervised driving is defined as driving with a licensed parent, guardian, or parent designee age 21 or older.

REFUND POLICY

If for any reason the student withdraws from the course before its completion, any refund will be based upon the following:

- a. The student is eligible for a full refund if Frankenmuth Driving School is notified of the decision to withdraw prior to the first class
- b. No refunds will be given after the first class
- c. Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed on an individual basis
